COOL POOL DECK INSERT

- Specification 2" OD, 1.5" ID, 6" Tall.
- 2 Parts 6" Base, Flush Mount Cap.
- The Cool Pool Stainless Steel Deck Insert has been precision made from 303 Grade Stainless Steel.
- Designed to receive any Volleyball Support or Umbrella with a 1.5" ID.
- The SSDI Insert is designed to be installed into your patio decking or directly into your pool.
- Includes custom-made Stainless Steel caps that will seat flush with your decking.
- Includes a Stainless Steel grounding screw enabling this part to be bonded to your pool.

COOL POOL UMBRELLA SLEEVE US Patent # 11,199,018 B2

- Specifications 2" OD, 1.5" ID 8" Tall.
- 3 parts 6" Base, 2" Umbrella Adapter, Flush Mount Cap.
- Cool Pool's Patented Stainless Steel Umbrella Sleeve is made from 303 Grade Stainless Steel.
- Designed to receive any Umbrella with a 1.5" OD pole.
- Includes grounding screw enabling this part to be bonded to your pool.
- Screw the Umbrella Adapter into the 6" base and tighten your Umbrella using the thumb screw.
- Remove the Umbrella Adapter from the deck when the Umbrella is removed.



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS - NEW CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Remove Stainless Steel cap and replace with the supplied PVC cap.
- 2. Locate the best position to install your deck insert or umbrella sleeve.
- 3. (Per code) Secure the bonding wire to the outer surface of the insert using the supplied grounding screw.
- 4. Position the sleeve into the concrete / plaster insuring that it is level and plumb.
- 5. Set the insert into the wet concrete or plaster so the top rim will remain flush with the decking.
- 6. Leave the plastic caps in place until the concrete has been set and the acid wash has been completed.
- 7. Allow decking to set and dry.
- 8. When completed, Remove the plastic cap and replace with the custom Stainless Steel cap.
- 9. Be sure to clean any debris from the threads and inside the insert.
- 10. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN THE STAINLESS STEEL CAP. Using a coin or fingers is all that is necessary.

<u>INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS - EXISTING POOL / RETROFIT</u>

- 1. Remove Stainless Steel cap and replace with the supplied PVC cap.
- 2. Locate the best position to install your deck insert or umbrella sleeve.
- 3. (Per code) Secure the bonding wire to the outer surface of the insert using the supplied grounding screw.
- 4. "Core Drill" a 2-1/2 3" hole at least 6" deep.
- 5. Set the insert with your setting compounds of choice. (Concrete, Plaster, Quick Crete Anchoring Cement, Etc.)
- 6. Set the insert so the top rim will remain flush with the decking.
- 7. Allow your work to set up and dry.
- 8. Leave the plastic cap in place until the concrete has been set and the acid wash has been completed.
- 9. Remove the plastic cap and replace with the Stainless Steel cap.
- 10. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN THE STAINLESS STEEL CAP. Using a coin or fingers is all that is necessary.

IMPORTANT MAINTENANCE TIPS

- 1. Proper care is recommended with saline or saltwater pools. You should frequently rinse your Stainless Steel with fresh water to avoid salt staining.
- 2. Do not over tighten the Stainless Steel caps.
